ORDINANCE NO. 929

AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH REQUIREMENTS FOR AN EMERGENCY VARIANCE PERMIT CONCERNING TEMPORARY PLACEMENT OF MOBILE HOMES AND TRAVEL TRAILERS AS A RESULT OF DAMAGES CAUSED BY HURRICANE LAURA

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of DeQuincy, State of Louisiana, met on September 10, 2020 to put into place an emergency ordinance regarding the placement of mobile homes and travel trailers at residences, within the city limits, that have been damaged due to Hurricane Laura;

BE IT ORDAINED that homeowners will apply for an Emergency Variance Permit and, after the Code Enforcement Officer goes to the address given on the application, and approves the application, a homeowner will be given a temporary permit;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this permit is to be displayed on the mobile home or travel trailer, in a prominent place that can be seen from the outside, and shall remain there for the duration of the permit;

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Emergency Variance Permit will expire on October 27, 2021, at which time an extension, if needed, must be requested by the homeowner.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
